## ADVANCED SAIL TRIM COURSE



Now that you have learned to sail and navigate safely, have you been hoping for an opportunity to fine-tune your sail trim skills? To better understand what will increase the performance and ease of operation of your boat? If so, spend the weekend with us aboard “Persuasion” (Wylie 52 Custom Racer) and one of our mid 40’s sailing yachts.

This course will begin 9 AM Saturday and conclude Sunday 5 PM. Saturday will be spent sailing one of our larger yachts with Saturday night anchored in a secluded bay enjoying a “BYO” BBQ and swapping sea stories. Sunday morning, after more training, you’ll return to the dock and switch to “Persuasion” to put your training to the test aboard this precision racer!
