## **GALLEY**

The galley has a NovaKool refrigerator/freezer, and a three-burner propane stove with oven. At the sink is a water filtration system.

There are three 6' throw rugs and 3 smaller throw rugs on the floor.

- Adult inflatable vest type life preservers (4) located in staterooms, plus 4 additional life vests in storage bag under salon. Instructions for use are in the mesh bag in the hanging locker of the forward stateroom.
- Life ring mounted on rail at stern
- ABANDON SHIP BAG Fluorescent green bag located on top of hanging locker in second stateroom
- Throwable EZ docker mooring line located in Lazarette
- Fire extinguishers (5)
  - one affixed to the wall of the Galley next to the stern door;
  - one affixed to the port-side helm station wall next to the door;
  - one affixed to the wall in the head
  - one under the helm seat
  - one attached to the forward bulkhead of the engine room
- Horn at helm station.
- Flare kit under the seat at the helm station

- Flashlights (3): one located at the helm, one in the engine room next to the paper towel holder, and a third in the drawer under the TV screen.
