There are two texts that you will need. They are the “Sailing Fundamentals”, by Gary Jobson, and “The Cruising Fundamentals” by Harry Munns. All of your provisioning is provided during the week, with the exception of one night you’ll eat ashore at Friday Harbor, enjoying the local island environment and cuisine. We are thrilled to be able to offer you this wonderful opportunity to learn from experienced female sailors, in a relaxed environment with other women.
