*****SAFETY GEAR*****

Please take time to familiarize yourself with the location and operation of the safety gear.

- Throwable EZ docker mooring line located in Lazarette inside a gray bag.
- Yellow life ring behind boat deck ladder in aft cockpit.
- Mariah two-way voice activated headsets at the office station for communication with the captain when docking.
- **Fire extinguishers** (4) portable.
 - one affixed to the wall in the salon next to the entry door.
 - one affixed to the aft wall in the helm station.
 - one affixed to the wall in the office station.
 - one attached to the forward bulkhead of the engine room.
- Horn at helm station. (port overhead compartment).
- **Flare kit** in pilot house on bookshelf, and in tender under seat.
- Flashlights located in the helm chart drawer and one in the engine room near aft port bulkhead on the toolbox, and 1 in salon on cabinet next to the ice maker, 2 at the office station.
- Bilge pumps (3) located in the engine room, below the hatch in the step to master stateroom, and in the Lazarette (The bilge pumps are spring loaded to the automatic position (at the office control panel.)
- Wooden seacock plugs attached with nylon line to each seacock
- **First aid kit** at office station.
